The Asia IDDSI Conference 2026 welcomes abstract submissions from researchers, clinicians, dietitians, speech-language therapists, food technologists, and other professionals involved in the implementation, education, and innovation of the International Dysphagia Diet Standardisation Initiative (IDDSI). This conference provides a platform to share evidence-based practices, implementation strategies, novel product development, and real-world experiences related to texture-modified diets and dysphagia care.

All presentations will be conducted in English

- **Submission Deadline:** 15th May 2026
- **Notification of Acceptance:** July 2026
- **Presenter Registration Deadline:** 1st August 2026

Abstract Submission Categories

Submissions (in English) may fall under the following categories:

1. Clinical Practice & Implementation
2. Research Studies (Quantitative/Qualitative/Mixed Methods)
3. Product or Technology Innovation
4. Food Service and Catering Solutions
5. Education and Training in IDDSI

General Guidelines

- Abstracts must be written in **English** and submitted via email: asiaevents@iddsi.net
- Word limit: **250–300 words** (excluding title, authors, and affiliations)
- The abstract title has a character limit of 150 characters not including spaces.
- The abstract should clearly state the **background, objective, methods, results, and conclusion/implications**.
- All abstracts must be **original** and not previously published or presented at another international conference.

Formatting Instructions

- **Title:** Bold, sentence case (e.g., *Implementing IDDSI in ABCDEHospitals: A Multidisciplinary Approach*)
- **Keywords:** Presenting authors must provide at least two keywords associated with the content area
- **Author(s):** Full name(s), institutional affiliation(s), city, and country
- **Presenting author:** Indicate with (*) after the author's name
- **Suggested Font:** Times New Roman, 12-point
- **File type:** Submit as a Microsoft Word document (.doc or .docx)

Review Process

- All submissions will undergo **peer review** by the IDDSI Scientific Committee.
- Abstracts will be evaluated based on **relevance to IDDSI, clarity, methodological rigor, innovation, and impact**.
- Selected abstracts may be accepted for **oral presentation** or **poster presentation**.

Conference Presentation Formats

- **Oral Presentations:** 7 minutes + 3-minute Q&A
- **E-Poster Presentations:** portrait orientation; authors are required to be available for discussion during the designated session.
